VCS REOPENING PLAN

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Plans for next school year

VCS will closely monitor all recommendations and may change or alter this plan as needed throughout the 2020-21 school year.

TRADITIONAL SCHOOL



- Students will have school in the classroom. Teachers will use a variety of teaching methods, including digital and paper.
- Safety and cleaning measures will be implemented for traditional students. More details for this plan on p. 4.
- Traditional students can seamlessly transfer to a virtual platform when necessary.

VIRTUAL SCHOOL



- Students will follow along with their class through an online feed of the classroom and complete assignments using RenWeb/FACTS LMS. Assessments will be administered by a VCS staff member.
- Virtual students will be required to have a technology device and internet connection in their home.
- Students will be able to transfer back to traditional classroom with administration approval.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS



- Each parent/guardian will be asked to fill out a health screening form for their children before returning to the classroom.
- School staff will be performing temperature checks at the entrances to school each morning. Any students with temperatures of 100.4 or higher will be asked to work from home until symptom free.
- All classrooms/restrooms will be thoroughly cleaned each day and throughout the day. Disinfectant wipes and UV lamps will be available for frequent disinfecting.
- Classroom supplies will not be shared unless properly cleaned between uses.
- Students/Teachers may be asked to wear masks when feasible and physical distancing is not possible. An example of this would be when traveling in the hallways or between classes. This may change depending on the recommendations of the ADPH and CDC guidelines.
- All class schedules will be adjusted to help with social distancing from other grades.
- Although social distancing is not always possible in the classroom, desks/tables will be arranged in the best way to maintain distance in the classrooms.
- Sanitation stations will be located throughout the school.
- Students who develop a fever during the school day will be placed in an area away from students with a mask until someone is able to pick them up from campus.
- At this time, parents/visitors will not be allowed in the classrooms or lunchroom. This will be re-evaluated as the school year progresses.

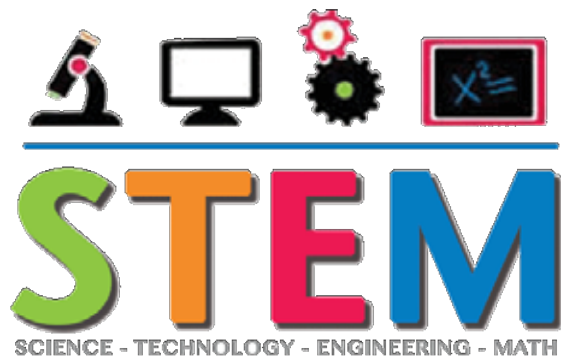

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- All athletics (7th-12th) will follow the guidelines set by the AHSAA. Currently, all fall sports will be played as originally scheduled.
- There will be no field trips during the first quarter of school. VCS will reassess the situation as conditions change.
- After school clubs will not meet at the beginning of the school year, but may be able to as conditions improve. i.e. Scholars Bowl, STEM Club, Key Club, Builders Club, etc.
- Early Care and After School Care will be modified for physical distancing. Temperatures may be taken at the beginning of After School Care each day.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Will students be able to attend P.E.?**

Yes, students will attend P.E. each day. Each grade goes to the gym for a 40 minute class. They will also be able to go outside and get fresh air when weather permits.

- **Will students have to wear masks?**

Generally, no, but there may be times when students and teachers will be required to wear masks in transition times. Students are welcome to wear masks at all times.

- **Will we have pep rallies/Lion Cubs?**

Yes, but they may be moved to the football field, depending on the current conditions. Lion Cubs will also be able to cheer this year.

- **Will students eat lunch in the lunchroom?**

Yes, each grade will enter and leave at separate times throughout the day. They will have assigned tables and will be sanitized before another grade comes in to the lunchroom.

- **Will students be able to have chapel ?**

Yes, the auditorium is set up with all the rows six feet apart. There will be two separate chapels each week, one for K4-4th and one for 5th-12th grades.

- **Will virtual student tuition be adjusted?**

No, virtual and traditional students will have the same tuition and fees. VCS is adding technology to be able to accommodate virtual learning and a seamless transition from classroom to home.
